Dear Friends and Well Wishers

It is a proud moment for the Tehzibul Akhlaq Trust to present its Annual Report 2022. The frequent interruption of the school year due to Covid rendered it impossible to present a Report of the yearly activities in 2021. However, this year, by the Grace of Allah, was a normal academic one and studies, co-curricular activities of the school as well as the endeavors of the Trust resumed with the habitual fervor.

I would like to reiterate the Trust's underlying vision: we want to promote national harmony. Our aim is to attract students from under privileged areas of the country, assist them through our Tehzibul Akhlaq Outreach Program to enter our educational institutions, nurture them in a clean and healthy environment thus help them become patriotic, open-minded **Pakistanis** who are above regional and ethnic prejudices. We have 250 students Balochistan, from Waziristan, Kashmir, Sind and other parts of the country at our Manga Campus, out of which 148 are TOP scholars. Learning together, playing together and sharing beautiful moments of student life will, we hope, create a bond for life.

This year has also witnessed the commencement of our Sir Syed

College of Management Sciences in our Gulberg campus, which is affiliated with the University of Punjab. Our dream of NAU is Alhumdullilah becoming a reality. The construction contract was awarded to Messers Bannu Mukhtar. The ground breaking was performed on 25th March 2022 by Mian Shamim Ahmad, who was the senior most Trustee and oldest living Alig aged over 100 years. The first phase of the project is now estimated to cost Rs 100 crores, which is entirely being raised through donations. We are grateful to all our wellwishers who have contributed towards its construction. However. we have a shortfall of about Rs 50 crores, which we are hoping will be met by generous donors. Our fundraising campaign is in full swing. I am confident that our friends will not disappoint us and donations will continue to flow in, which will allow us to reach completion. The process of filing application for grant of University Charter is under finalization and is expected to be filed early 2023. The condition of Endowment Fund is also being complied with. Its' Board of Directors, Rules approved and registration is being processed. Our Alumni, The Aligarians, is now well established and working towards locating old students of



both campuses.

I would like to appreciate the encouragement and support of all the Trustees, the hard work of our faculty, the diligence of the heads of the educational institutions and untiring efforts of my Team which made this year a success. I would also like to thank all our donors, both of NAU Project as well as TOP scholarships, whose generosity helps us to expand as well as bring new students to our institutions.

HOW WE STEER OUR MISSION TOWARDS REALITY

Mission	To provide affordable and accessible quality education for individual growth, socio-economic development and nation building.
Vision	To establish and sustain institutions that offer quality education, nurture patriotism and inculcate moral values.
Theme	To create National Harmony by bringing students from far-flung backward areas and integrating them into the education mainstream of the country.

The Tehzibul Akhklaq Trust aims to offer high quality education at the lowest fee possible. All our Trust members offer their services voluntarily. No facilities of any kind are offered. A small group of full-time employees carries out the day-to-day work.

In order to be sustainable, the educational institutions charge a moderate fee which covers operating expenditure. Scholarships and concessions are offered generously. A special committee examines the applications and awards scholarships on need basis. Children of school employees are exempted from paying fees. Merit scholarships for high achievers are also offered.

The schools are registered with the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Lahore. The medium of instruction is English, and both Science and Arts subjects are offered.

All capital expenditure i.e. construction cost is met through donations. The sincerity of purpose, dedication, and trustworthiness of our pioneers has been able to convince philanthropists to donate to our cause and by the Grace of Allah, this continues to be the case even today.

The Tehzibul Akhlaq Trust aims to equip the youth with modern knowledge and instill the values of our religion and culture in them. We inspire to raise good Muslims, patriotic citizens and in the case of non-Muslim students, young people with good moral values. Our special emphasis is on promoting national harmony.

The schools offer coeducation till primary level, then boys and girls are assigned to different sections so that they can be allowed to grow in environments conducive to their respective natures.

Since academic excellence is an important part of the school goals, highly qualified faculty is recruited. Students with difficulties are offered remedial classes after school free of cost.



TEHZIBUL AKHLAQ OUTREACH PROGRAM (TOP)

In line with our theme of National Harmony, in 2020 we started TOP for boarding school at Manga, which already has the unique feature of having boarders from class one onwards. For this purpose applications are

invited through national dailies asking children to appear for written test with National Testing Service. Interviews are conducted, result based, by school staff at various locations. Selection is finally done strictly on merit. These scholarships are fully funded by donors, the average all inclusive fee is Rs 2.50 lacs per child per year. NEW ALIGARH UNIVERSITY

Ground Breaking of NAU

Requisite approvals from LDA etc. were obtained in 2021 for the construction of first academic block at Manga, Lahore, comprising of ground plus five floors, each of 20,000 sq.feet. The approval also includes construction of a Multi Purpose Hall of around 25,000 sq.feet having a capacity of 450 students. Being an NPO and a non-commercial entity, all capital expenditure since inception has been carried out through donations. Alhumdulillah this Project too is being undertaken with the generous donation of philanthropists.

In first phase, due to fund constraints, it is decided to construct Multi Purpose Hall and ground plus one floor only of the Academic Block, with the option of adding another floor (subject to availability of funds). MPH is being entirely funded by one of the Trustees family.

The NAU project was further divided into Grey Structure and MEP. Accordingly, after prequalification ITB was floated on 9th December 2021, as firm offer for Grey and optional offer for MEP. Four renowned contractors gave offers. The bids were opened on 26.1.2022 and after evaluation by the Construction Committee a Letter of Award was issued on 14th March. The Contract Agreement was finally executed with Messers Banu Mukhtar on 24th March 2022.

The ground breaking of the Project was performed on 25th March 2022 by late Mian Shamim Ahmad, who was the senior most Trustee aged plus 100 years on that occasion. Work is progressing as per schedule and first phase is expected to be completed by 2023.


